**Congressmen Aaron Schock's  
Fiscal Year 2010 Appropriations Requests  
For Tazewell County**

Just a quick update concerning the Congressmen's Appropriations Request that has been in the news. I wanted to provide a listing of those request involving Tazewell County. Here is the listing:

- A) **\$144,000 for the Tazewell County Sheriff's Department**  
To assist in technology upgrades for the Tazewell County Sheriff's Department
- B) **\$5.0 million for Illinois Central College**  
The funding would strengthen Illinois community colleges' capacity to promote energy education and sustainable practices.
- C) **\$180,000 for the Village of Hopedale**  
The funding would be used to conduct preliminary work on a new wastewater treatment plant.
- D) **\$660,000 for the Village of South Pekin**  
The funding would be used to replace the village's existing water tower with a new 150,000 gallon water tower.
- E) **\$1.0 million for the Village of North Pekin**  
The funding would be used to make improvements to Main Street, thus improving safety on a heavily traveled road.
- F) **\$1.0 million for Veterans Drive**  
The funding would be used to design, engineer, and acquire land for Veterans Drive in Pekin.
